The History of Concrete Payement on I-59 in NE Alabama



pavement on I-59 in NE Alabama has been a great investment by ALDOT. Traveling from Milepost 194.5 near Gadsden to the Georgia State Line, few motorists realize they are traveling over the original pavement placed in the mid 1960's. What is more amazing is that the pavement was designed for only 20 years but lasted over 50 years!

ALDOT is beginning to replace this pavement with the first project to bid in November.

Future In 2010 ALDOT replaced

11 miles of concrete pavement just south of the project mentioned above. To date no maintenance has been required on this pavement. We expect another 30 years of service.

This 11 mile project attracted 8 concrete bidders. ALDOT estimated bid price was between \$50,680,000 and \$61,900,000. The project cost was only \$37,496,528, \$13 Million below the estimated cost.
